## **INTRODUCTION**

The EU4EU - Erasmus+ project, founded by the non-profit association EuGen, has been running since 2015 and also in this two-year period 2021-2022 has been confirmed as a successful and continuously improving European project. EU4EU intends to be a real "link" between university students wishing to enrich their professional profile with a traineeship abroad, and the Host Organizations, i.e. the European companies welcoming young professionals in the program with a view to the international exchange of knowledge and skills.

Also part of the EU4EU European project are the 45 Partner Universities of the Italian, Portuguese, Spanish and French consortia that have decided to collaborate with EuGen and offer their students this valuable work opportunity.

Students, Host Organizations and Universities take part in the EU4EU project completely free of charge.

During the biennium 2021–2022, the EU4EU European project grew in numbers – as the above picture clearly shows – but not only. The technology used to manage the program has seen significant improvements. Every step of EU4EU passes through the website www.eu4eu.org and, in particular, through the use of the EU4EU Portal, it is possible to manage one's participation in the program in every aspect, conveniently and in a short time. Moreover, within the numerous sections of the website, documents, videos, images, information and news are available, all constantly updated by the EuGen team.

And with regard to the team of both EuGen and the EU4EU project, it has taken a more stable and defined form and features three young women, each with a different role and competence.

EU4EU's constant collaborative work with all its partners led to the creation of a real network of European companies which, in addition to being part of the program in order to quickly identify the most suitable candidates for their traineeships abroad, are also satisfied with the easy way in which they can get in touch with each other. In fact, interesting relationships of collaboration and mutual support between Host Organizations are created over time through the fundamental project node. In this way, companies enrolled in the EU4EU European program also approach the project to spread their mission, to make themselves known and to look for collaboration opportunities with other European realities in an immediate and safe way.







## **STAFF MOBILITY**

As foreseen by the Erasmus+ program, also in the framework of the EU4EU project, Staff Mobility events took place, meeting events between the European project partners and also places where they could get to know each other in person despite living in different countries. These important moments were confirmed as excellent occasions to evaluate together the progress of the project, the novelties, the possible improvements, and for an intercultural exchange that every time enriches all participants. Unfortunately, in 2021 it was not possible to hold these meetings in person due to Covid–19, but in 2022 the activity luckily restarted, making 3 meetings possible.

The first and second meetings took place in Croatia in May 2022. On these occasions, staff from France, Italy and Spain met to discuss the 3 main points of the new European policy agenda and the Erasmus program: Inclusion, Environmental Sustainability and Digitalisation. During the meetings, the people present carried out various activities and, above all, engaged in useful and constructive dialogue.







The third Staff Mobility took place in Rome (Italy) in September 2022 and featured the consortium of Portuguese partner universities, whose representatives met the Italian staff of the EU4EU project.

The 3 days that EU4EU Italy staff spent with university representatives were rich in exchanges, updates and above all dialogue, all aimed at finding the best strategies to optimally inform Portuguese students about the opportunity that EU4EU represents and to increase their presence among all the young people who enroll in the program and complete the steps foreseen to win the precious European scholarship.






## **TRAINEES FIELD OF STUDIES**













## **SENDING UNIVERSITIES (TOP 10)**








## **DESTINATION COUNTRIES (TOP 5)**








## TRAINEES SELECTED FIELD OF INTERNSHIPS








## TRAINEES POSITION DURING THE INTERNSHIPS










## **SATISFACTION WITH THE INTERNSHIPS**








## **TRAINEES WORKING AFTER INTERNSHIPS**










## **CLASSIFICATION OF HOST ORGANIZATIONS**













## FIELDS OF AVAILABLE INTERNSHIPS (TOP 10)








## **LANGUAGES REQUIRED FOR INTERNSHIPS**








## **DURATION OF INTERNSHIPS**








## **NUMBER OF TRAINEES REQUIRED**








## **LEVEL OF SATISFACTION WITH THE EU4EU PROGRAM**
