



- Planning , preparation , implementation of mobility activities and follow up.





38 participants with a letter of acceptance

34 grants from Campus Iberus

4 students on the waiting list

Lessons learned

- Dissemination is key , only 10 % of the participants are successful getting an acceptance letter.
- Students do not read the call: workshops, whatsapp, telegram
- Lack of knowledge about European projects, the participants are looking for their field.
- High percentage of participants who cancel their stay: expensive lifestyle, housing difficulties for 3 - 4 months, mental problems.

Future Goals

- 1. Increase the number of participating companies to enhance opportunities for students and staff.
- 2. Foster partnerships with European-based companies to provide exposure to transnational projects.
- 3. Pursue collaboration with EUGen for a Key Action 2 (KA2) project. 4. Other types of mobilities: short stays, BIP...
