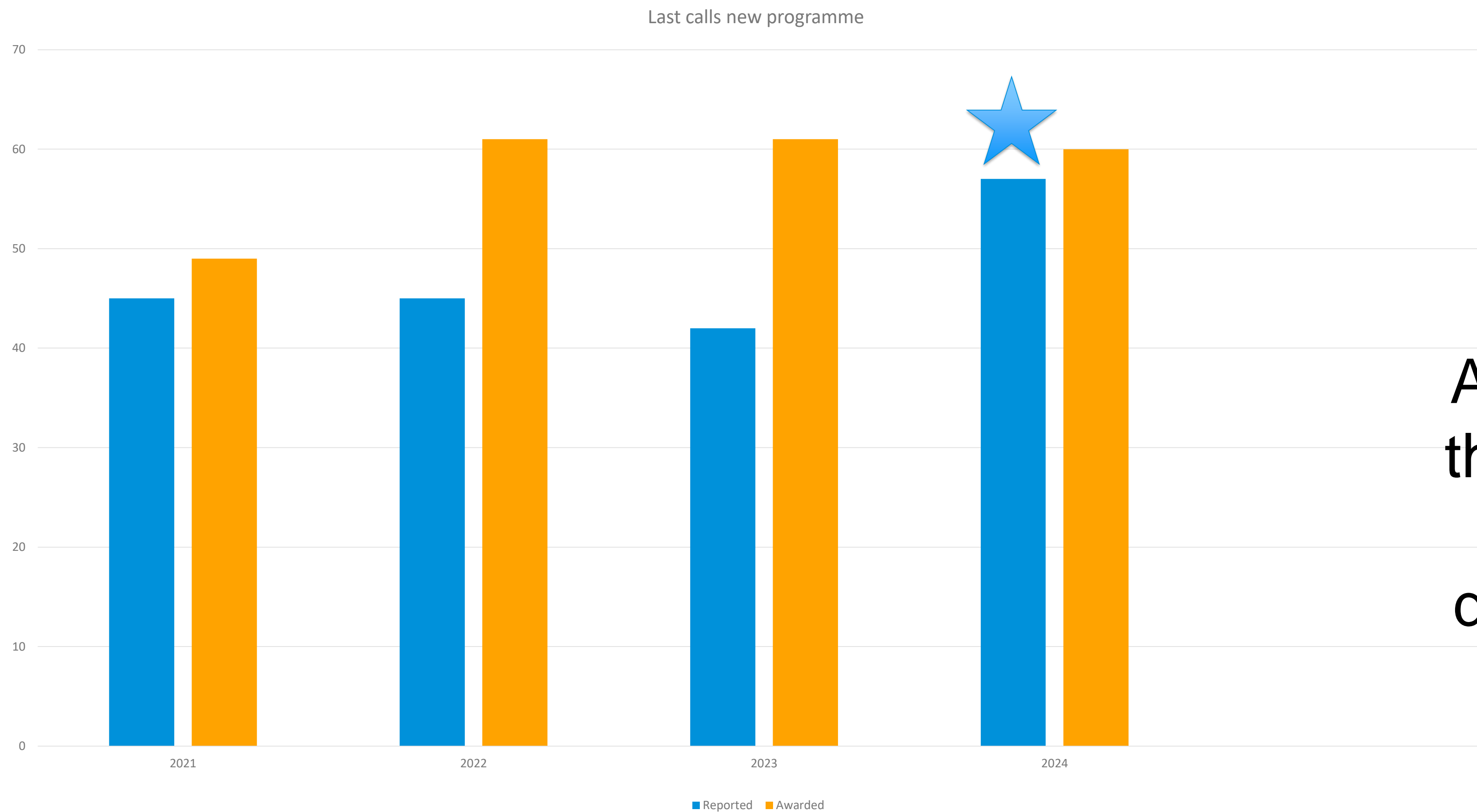

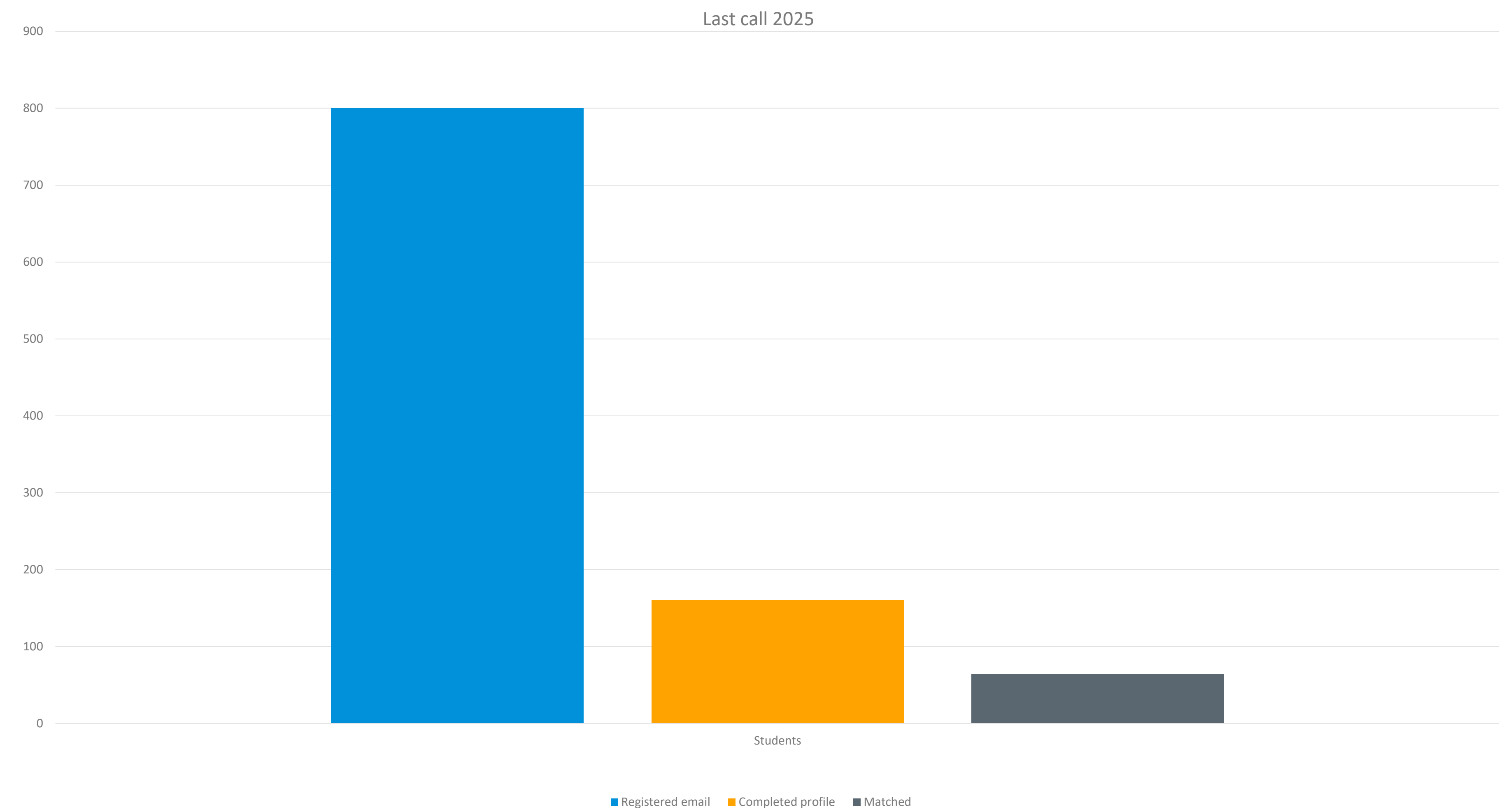

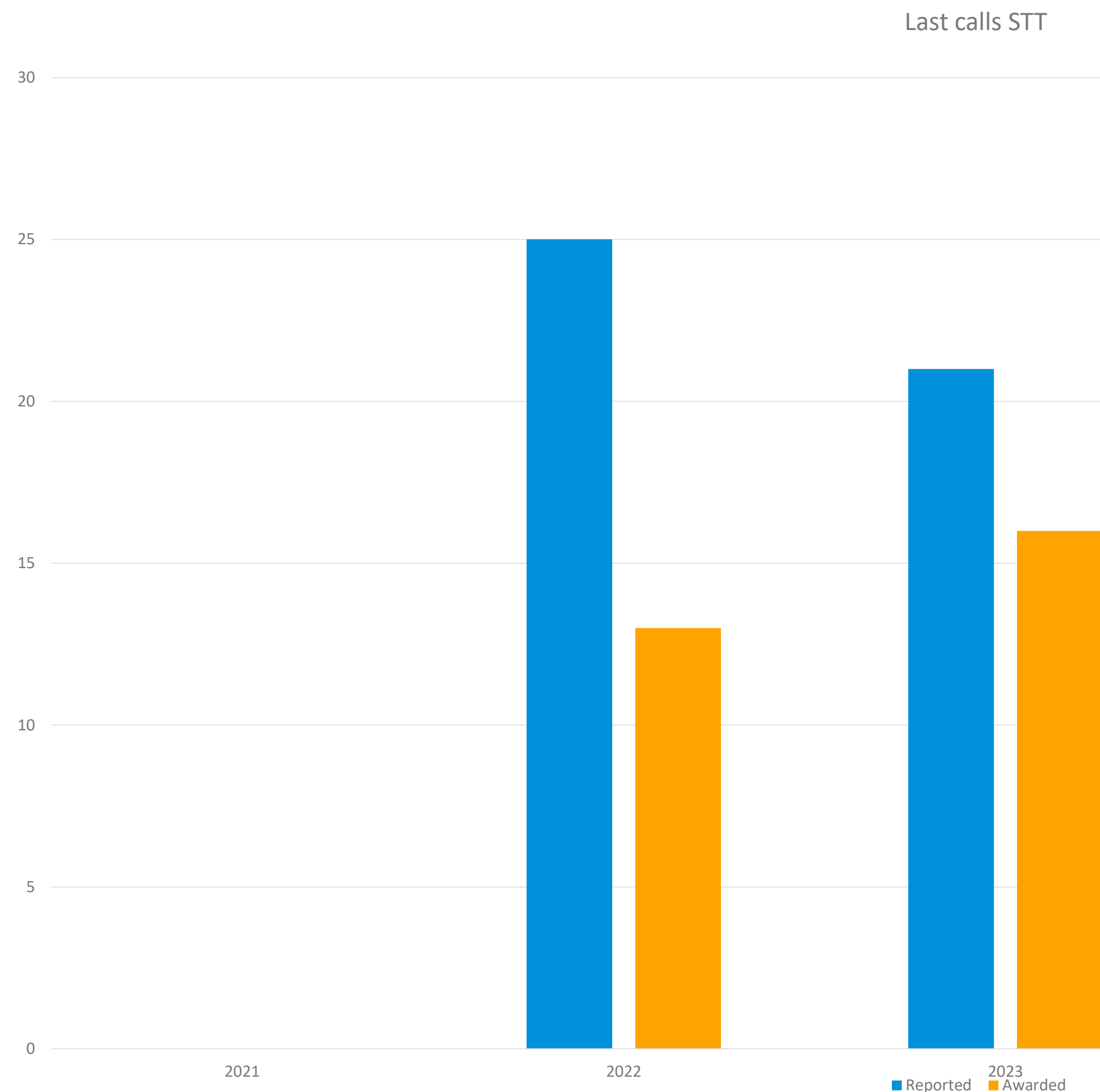

5. To learn about existing funding mechanisms in Higher Education in Colombia. To explore opportunities for Spanish universities to apply to these programmes.



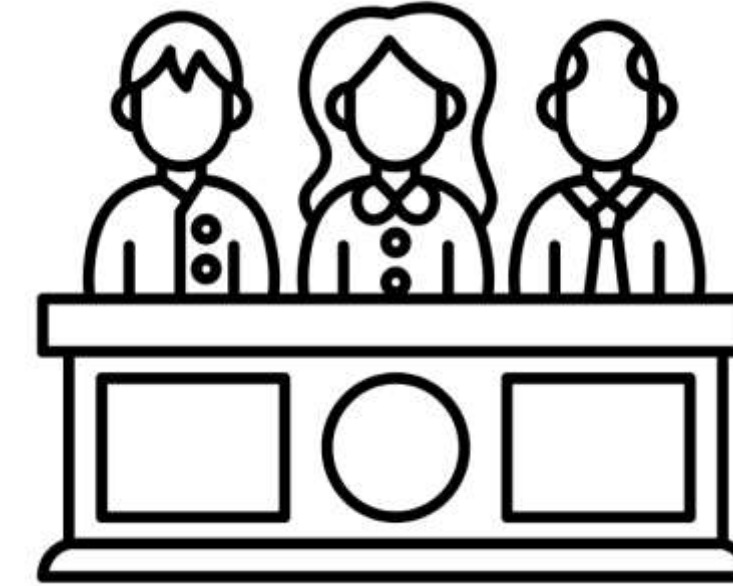

Main host countries

1. Italy
2. Bélgica
3. Alemania

Main reasons cancellations mobilities

1. Insufficient allowance to cover actual costs of living in the destination country.
2. Difficulties in finding accommodation at the destination.
3. Problems with the host institution.
4. Professional opportunity that they prioritize over mobility.

Solutions applied to lower cancellations

1. EUGEN database for accomodation.
2. Workshop online emphasizing the grant per month. Increasing the grant in the last call.
3. Whatsapp number and Whatsapp group from Campus Iberus to facilitate the communication with the participants.

Reports from the participants

- Participants show a high level of satisfaction with the mobility stay.
- Some of them repeat the experience in future calls.
- Many recommend the programme to their colleagues.
- A positive and enriching impact on their personal and professional development is perceived.
- The experience is seen as valuable and recommendable in their academic career.
