What is EU4EU?

- A European program promoting international traineeships.
- Managed by EuGen in a consortium with 12 Italian universities.
- Objective: Facilitate the transition from university to the job market.

Why Participate?

- An experience that enhances your CV and opens doors to Europe.
- Improves language, digital, and interpersonal skills.
- Creates international professional and networking opportunities.

Participating Universities

- Tuscia, Bari, Cagliari, Catania, Napoli Federico II, Padova, Parma, Perugia, Roma Sapienza, Roma Tor Vergata, Teramo, Politecnica Delle Marche.
- All are part of the EU4EU Italy Consortium.

Learning Objectives



Development of skills in:

- Europroject design and management of European projects.
 - Project design, communication, marketing, digital skills.
 - Business and administration.
- Focus: Transversal skills and employability.

Who Can Apply?

- Students enrolled in a high school qualification/pre-university course, master's, single-cycle degrees, master's programs, or PhDs.
- Open to recent graduates, master's degree holders, or PhD holders.
- Also eligible: students who are off-track.

Eligibility Requirements

- Enrollment at one of the Consortium universities.
- English level B1 or higher.
- Minimum 60 days of mobility remaining in the current study cycle.
- No overlapping with other EU-funded grants.

Grounds for Exclusion

- Missing or incorrect eligibility requirements.
- Taking exams during the internship period.
- Graduation or degree completion before the end of the traineeship.

Destination Countries

- All EU Members States + Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, North Macedonia, Serbia, Turkey.
- The internship cannot take place in the country of the home university.



Duration and Period

- Duration: Minimum 60 days, maximum 150 consecutive days.
- Project 2025: 12 January – 31 December 2026.
- Project 2024: 12 January – 31 July 2026.
- Possible blended modality (part in-person + part online).

Academic Recognition

- The internship is recognized as an Erasmus+ training experience.
- CFU credits awarded according to each university's regulations.

Monitoring and Quality

- Entry survey (optional, to report issues).
- Outcome survey (mandatory, condition for final payment).
- Follow-up survey (5 months after the internship ends).

Financial Support

Monthly amount varies by host country.

Funding based on two Erasmus+ projects:

- 2025 (up to 60th place in the ranking)
- 2024 (from 60th place onwards).

Project 2025

Grant Amounts

- Group 1 – High cost of living: €550/month.
- Group 2 – Medium-low cost of living: €500/month.

Travel contribution calculated based on distance (EU Commission)

Project 2024

Grant Amounts

- Group 1 – High cost of living: €500/month.
- Group 2 – Medium-low cost of living: €450/month.
- No travel contribution provided.

Zero Grant and University Funds

- Students may participate as 'Erasmus Zero Grant' (no financial support).
- Universities may use their own funds to support eligible non-selected students.



Students with Fewer Opportunities

- Additional €250/month.
- Applicable for those with ISEE certification \leq €27,948.60 (2024-2025).
- Requires uploading the document on the EU4EU portal.

Grant Payments

- Two installments: 80% at the start + 20% at the end of the internship.
- If scholarship > €2,500: Three installments (50% + 30% + 20%).
- All payments within 30 days of completing required formalities.

Online Application



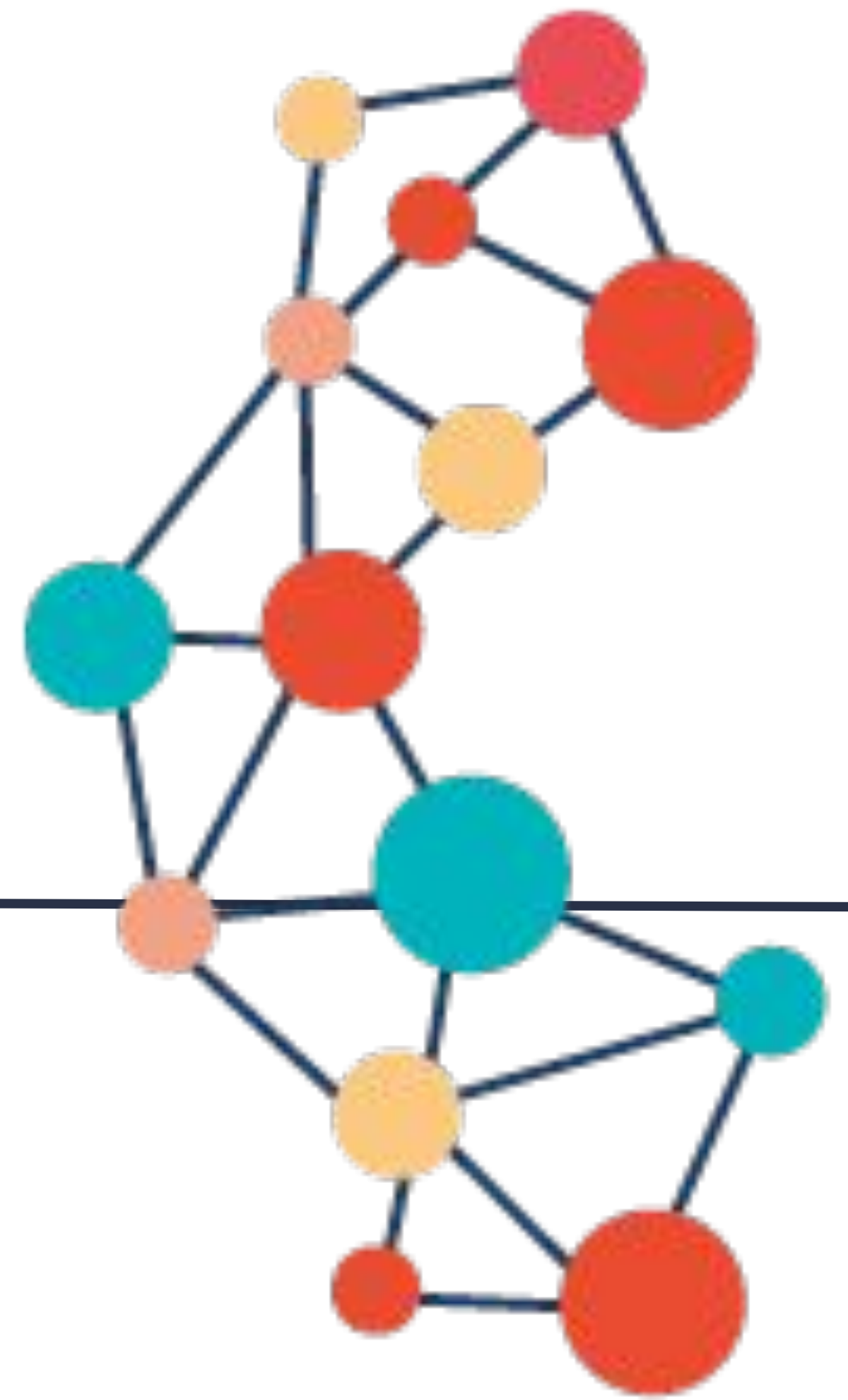
- Only through: <https://eng.eu4eu.org/eu4eu-portal/>
- Phases: Pre-registration → Registration → Matching.
- Pre-registration: 1-24 October 2025.
- Registration: 25 October – 10 November 2025.
- Matching: 29 October – 3 December 2025.

Advantages of Pre-registration

- +5 points in the ranking.
- Early access to Host Organization offers.
- Higher chances of finding the ideal internship.

Required Documents

- CV in English (PDF).
- Motivation letter in English.
- Language certification at B1 level or higher (dated \geq 1 January 2023).
- Declaration of Compliance, digitally signed.



Matching Phase

- Completed by uploading the signed Letter of Availability.
- Application is valid only after uploading.
- All communications occur via email.

HOST ORGANIZATION

- Chosen from the EU4EU database or proposed by the candidate.
- Must be registered on the EU4EU Portal.
- Must be in an eligible country and have an available tutor.

Host Organization Requirements



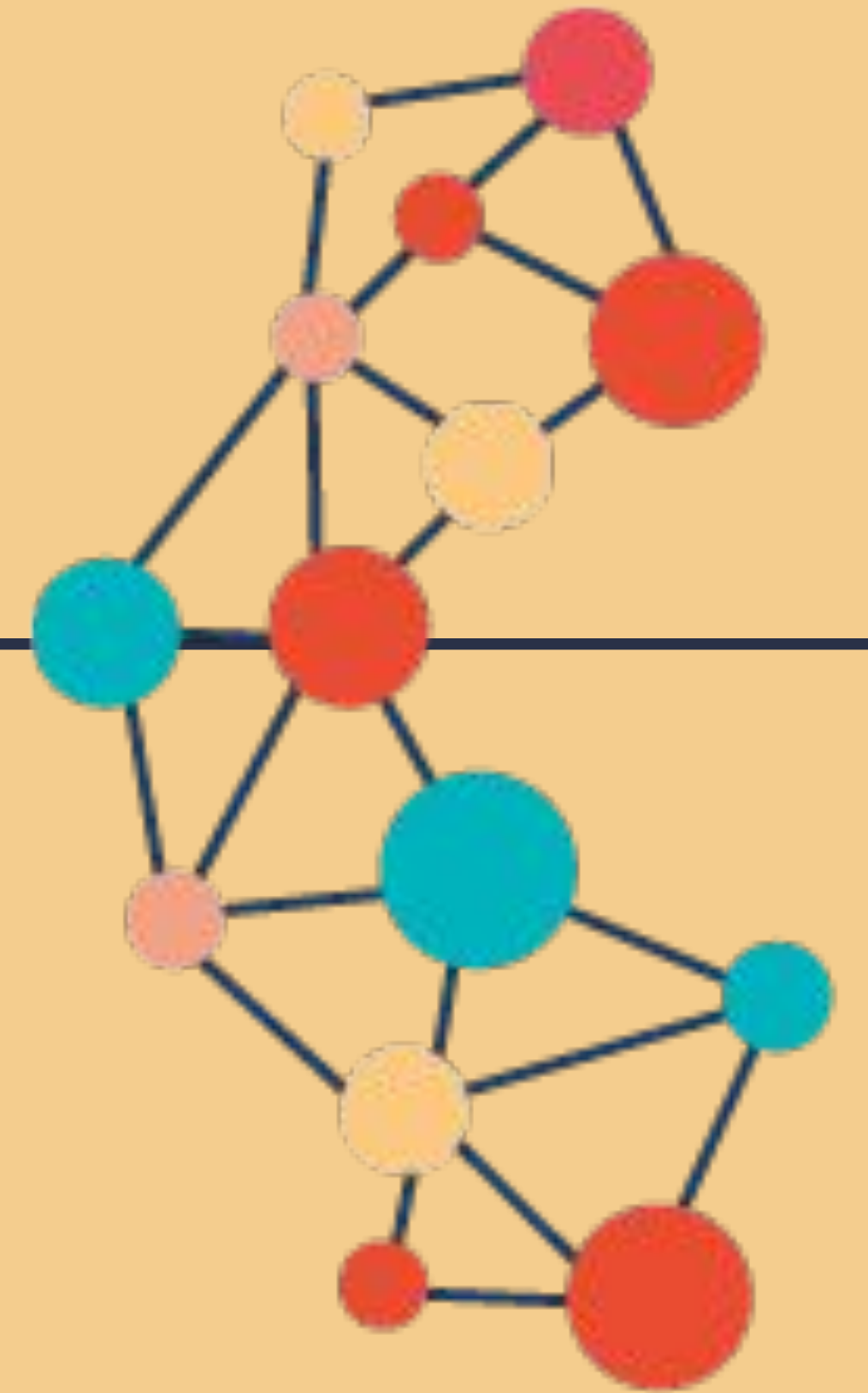
- Public or private entity active in work, training, or research.
- Not allowed: EU institutions or Erasmus+ agencies.
- Evaluated for reliability and alignment with EU values.

Selection Criteria

- Focus on euoproject design (15 points).
- Match between profile and internship (50 points).
- Language skills (15 points).
- Bonus: +5 points for pre-registration + 5 points for matching by 22 November.

Ranking and Results

- Minimum 40/80 points to be eligible.
- Publication by 17 December 2025, on www.eu4eu.org.
- Candidates notified via email.



Grant Acceptance



- Online acceptance on the Portal.
- Upload the Learning Agreement for Traineeship.
- Sign the Grant Agreement with EuGen.

Before Departure Preparation

- Accident and liability insurance coverage.
- TEAM health coverage or private insurance.
- Access to the EU Academy platform for language support.
- EU4EU information package with guides and resources.



Key Dates

- Pre-registration: 1-24 October 2025.
- Registration: 25 October – 10 November 2025.
- Matching: 29 October – 3 December 2025.
- Ranking publication: 17 December 2025.
- Internship start: From 12 January 2026.

How to Apply – Step by Step

- Read the call on www.eu4eu.org.
- Complete the online pre-registration.
- Prepare CV, motivation letter, and language certificate.
- Find a suitable Host Organization on the portal.
- Upload the Letter of Availability by 3 December 2025.
- Await the ranking and confirm the scholarship.



Student Declarations

- Applying implies declaring possession of all eligibility requirements.
- All information provided must be truthful and complete.
- Falsehoods or omissions lead to exclusion from the project and future EU4EU selections.
- Using the EU4EU Portal to contact Host Organizations outside the project is prohibited.
- Students interning with the same Host Organization after a withdrawal or without a scholarship must maintain “Zero Grant” status.
- Host Organizations must report any violations to the Consortium Coordinator.
